Food Choices

If your kitty is coming from our shelter in Ocala, s/he has been eating a mixture of Iams, Purina, Hill Science Diet and Royal Canin based on our recent donations.

If your kitty is coming from PetSmart, s/he has been eating Royal Canin or Authority provided by PetSmart.

All of our cats, regardless of location, enjoy a wide selection of wet food based on our recent donations.

Transitioning Food Brands

Start off with dry food as close to what is above as possible and transition new foods over a period of 7-10 days. This will help to minimize any stomach discomfort.

Days 1-3	75% old brand - 25% new brand
Days 4-6	50% old brand - 50% new brand
Days 7-10	25% old brand - 75% new brand
Days 10+	100% new brand
